NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that at an election to be held in the County Of Adams Wisconsin, on Tuesday, April 3, 2018 the following proposed Resolution of the Adams-Friendship Area School District, will be submitted to a vote of the people:

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL
DISTRICT BUDGET OT EXCEED THE REVENUE LIMIT
BY \$950,000 A YEAR FOR 5 YEARS
FOR NON-RECURRING PURPOSES**

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Adams-Friendship Area School District, Adams County, Wisconsin, that the revenues included in the School District budget be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91. Wisconsin Statutes, by \$950,000 a year for five years beginning with the 2018-2019 school year and ending with the 2022-2023 school year, for non-recurring purposes to sustain and enhance teaching and learning and to educate students to graduate with 21st century skills.

Adopted and Recorded January 8, 2018.

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

Shall the Adams-Friendship Area School District, Adams County, Wisconsin be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$950,000 a year for five years beginning with the 2018-2019 school year and ending with the 2022-2023 school year, for non-recurring purposes to sustain and enhance teaching and learning and to educate students to graduate with 21st century skills?

EXPLANATION

A yes vote will result in the Adams-Friendship Area School District, Adams County, Wisconsin being authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$950,000 a year for five years beginning with the 2018-2019 school year and ending with the 2022-2023 school year, for non-recurring purposes to sustain and enhance teaching and learning and to educate students to graduate with 21st century skills.

A no vote will result in the Adams-Friendship Area School District Adams County, Wisconsin not being authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$950,000 a year for five years beginning with the 2018-2019 school year and ending with the 2022-2023 school year, for non-recurring purposes to sustain and enhance teaching and learning and to educate students to graduate with 21st century skills.
