

NOTICE OF SPRING PRIMARY AND SAMPLE BALLOTS FEBRUARY 20, 2018
OFFICE OF THE ADAMS COUNTY CLERK TO THE VOTERS OF ADAMS COUNTY:

Notice is hereby given of a spring primary election to be held in Adams County, on the 20th of February, 2018, at which the officers named below shall be nominated. The names of the candidates for the office, given under the title of the office, in the sample ballots below.

INFORMATION TO VOTERS

Upon entering the polling place, a voter shall state his or her name and address, show an acceptable form of photo identification and sign the poll book before being permitted to vote. If a voter is not registered to vote, a voter may register to vote at the polling place serving his or her residence, if the voter presents proof of residence in a form specified by law. Where ballots are distributed to voters, the initials of two inspectors must appear on the ballot. Upon being permitted to vote, the voter shall retire alone to a voting booth or machine and cast his or her ballot, except that a voter who is a parent or guardian may be accompanied by the voter's minor child or minor ward. An election official may inform the voter of the proper manner for casting a vote, but the official may not in any manner advise or indicate a particular voting choice.


Where paper ballots are used, the voter shall make a mark (X) in the space next to the name of the candidate of his or her choice for which he or she intends to vote. To vote for a person whose name that does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall write in the name of the person of his or her choice in the space provided for a write-in vote. When using a tactile ballot marking device (vote-pad), to mark a paper ballot, the voter shall obtain from inspectors, the assistive device and any audio or dexterity aids if required. The voter shall fill in the space next to the name of the candidate of his or her choice for which he or she intends to vote. To vote for a person whose name that does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall write in the name of the person of his or her choice in the space provided for a write-in vote, and fill in the space next to the write-in line. After an official paper ballot is marked, it shall be folded so the inside marks do not show, but so the printed endorsements and inspectors' initials on the outside do show. The voter shall deposit the voted ballot in the ballot box, or deliver the ballot to an inspector for deposit, and leave the polling place promptly.

Where an optical scan voting system is used, the voter shall fill in the space next to the name of the candidate of his or her choice for which he or she intends to vote. To vote for a person whose name that does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall write in the name of the person of his or her choice in the space provided for a write-in vote, and fill in the space next to the write-in line. After an official optical scan ballot is marked, it shall be inserted in the security sleeve so the marks do not show. The voter shall then insert the ballot in the voting device, discard the sleeve, or deliver the ballot to an inspector for deposit. The voter shall leave the polling place promptly.

If the voter spoils a paper or optical scan ballot, he or she shall return it to an election official who shall issue another ballot in its place, but not more than three ballots shall be issued to any one voter. If the ballot has not been initialed by two inspectors or is defective in any other way, the voter shall return it to the election official, who shall issue a proper ballot in its place.

Where touch screen voting systems are used, the voter shall touch the screen next to the name of the candidate of his or her choice for which he or she intends to vote. To vote for a person whose name that does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall type in the name of the person of his or her choice in the space provided for a write-in vote. The vote should not be cast in any other manner. Not more than five minutes time shall be allowed at a machine. Sample ballots or other materials to assist the voter in casting his or her vote may be used. The sample ballot shall not be shown to anyone so as to reveal how the ballot is marked. The voter may spoil a touch screen ballot at the voting station before the ballot is cast. After an official touch screen ballot is marked, the voter shall leave the polling place promptly.

A voter may select an individual to assist in casting his or her vote if the voter declares to the presiding official that he or she is unable to read, has difficulty reading, writing or understanding English, or that due to disability is unable to cast his or her ballot. The selected individual rendering assistance may not be the voter's employer or an agent of that employer or an officer or agent of a labor organization which represents the voter. Notice to Voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by two election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See back of ballot for initials.)

Instructions to Voters

If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, ask an election inspector for help. (Absentee Voters: Contact your municipal clerk.)

To vote for a name on the ballot, make an "X" or other mark in the square next to the name, like this:

To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in."
