DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The project will include the reconstruction of CTH Z from Apache Avenue to Alpine Drive. Reconstruction will include the removing asphalt pavement, common excavation, placing base aggregate dense, pipe culverts, HMA pavement, MSG guardrail, timber bridge rail, pavement marking, signing and restoration.
